Mobility Blueprint provides tools and resources that help families find available housing within their school zone. Target Student Resources allows district and school leadership to view high concentration areas of students by address so that resources can be properly allocated.

ABOUT TARGET STUDENT RESOURCES

Because of the Covid-19 crisis, several notable needs have arisen including:

1. Providing meals to those in need while maintaining the health and wellness of workers, distributors and the community
2. Ensuring that students have access to computers
3. Ensuring that students have access to the internet/WiFi so they can stay connected to online resources while working from home
4. Delivering academic materials and resources so students can study at home

Target Student Resources was created as a direct response to help meet these needs quickly and efficiently. By partnering with local school districts who provide student-level data, Mobility Blueprint can upload the data to a secure system that allows users to easily view areas of high concentration, along with a report on student demographics and PEIMS data, in order to address all of the issues above.

ADDRESSES WITH 10 OR MORE STUDENTS

Authorized district and school leadership can scroll through a list of locations that house 10 or more students within the district. Each location generates a report that shows student demographics including age, grade, and school. Student data is updated each time the district provides new data to Mobility Blueprint. Principals and other school leaders can use this data to better allocate needed resources.

Target Student Resources permite a los líderes del distrito y de la escuela ver las áreas de alta concentración de los estudiantes por dirección para que los recursos se puedan asignar correctamente.

SOBRE TARGET STUDENT RESOURCES

Debido a la crisis de Covid-19, han surgido varias necesidades notables que incluyen:

1. Proporcionar comidas a los necesitados mientras se mantiene la salud y el bienestar de los trabajadores, los distribuidores y la comunidad.
2. Asegurarse de que los estudiantes tengan acceso a las computadoras
3. Asegurarse de que los estudiantes tengan acceso a Internet / WiFi para que puedan permanecer conectados a los recursos en línea mientras trabajan desde casa
4. Entrega de materiales y recursos académicos para que los estudiantes puedan estudiar en casa.

Target Student Resources se creó como una respuesta directa para ayudar a satisfacer estas necesidades de manera rápida y eficiente. Al asociarse con los distritos escolares locales que proporcionan datos a nivel de los estudiantes, Mobility Blueprint puede poner los datos en un sistema seguro que permite a los usuarios ver fácilmente las áreas de alta concentración, junto con un reporte sobre la demografía de los estudiantes y los datos de PEIMS, para enfrentar los problemas anteriores.

DIRECCIONES CON 10+ ESTUDIANTES

Los líderes autorizados del distrito y de la escuela pueden ver una lista de areas donde viven 10 o más estudiantes dentro del distrito. Cada area genera un reporte que muestra los datos demográficos de los estudiantes, incluyendo la edad, el grado y la escuela. Los datos de los estudiantes se actualizan cada vez que el distrito proporciona nuevos datos a Mobility Blueprint. Los directores y otros líderes escolares pueden usar esta información para asignar mejor los recursos necesarios.
