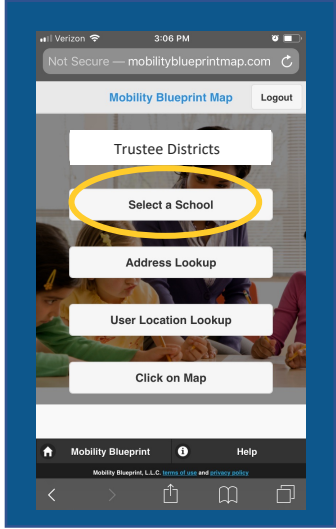


Use the Mobility Map on your desktop, iPad and other mobile devices including iPhone and Androids.

- Higher risk of dropping out of school

# Using the Mobility Map

1. Go to [www.MobilityBlueprint.net](http://www.MobilityBlueprint.net);
2. Click on **Mobility Map**;
3. Log on by providing your zip code or create an account;
4. Choose which school district to view;
5. Use the Menu to navigate. Search for schools, healthcare services, housing and/or transit.

Click on Clear Search to begin a new search.

Click on Transit Directions to search for possible routes between schools or from any address. Bus routes allow users to search by time of day.
